If required, any number of screens selected, or all screens can be blanked to gain attention and the keyboards and mice of computers selected can be locked. Ascot Coursemaster reduces costs by providing efficient training of groups as if training were being delivered one-to-one.

Ascot Coursemaster is available as either One-way (Show or View) or Multi-way (Select) systems.

- Irrespective of the room-seating layout all trainees are, in effect facing the instructor, offering one to one tuition to every member of the class.
- Audio communication can be incorporated in the initial installation or added to existing installations providing 2-way communication.
- The ability to discreetly and sequentially view some or all of the screens. The scanning speed can be varied.
- As Coursemaster is a hardware system, there is no annual software licence fee.
- In the unlikely event of Coursemaster failing, the PC's will still function as independent computers without any alterations to the system.
- Areas on the trainee's screen can be highlighted by the instructor to assist the trainee in problem solving.
- Available at various levels of operation that can be tailored to suit budget, whilst retaining the option of easy future expansion/variation.

Coursemaster Show allows the instructor's screen to be viewed by all the trainees. Course material is presented directly to the trainee's monitors allowing each trainee a clear view at their own screen. At any time the instructor may return control to the trainees, allowing them to return to work. To prevent trainees from being distracted during training, the instructor can blankout their screens. A second input for the instructor, for example a projector is also possible with this system.

The instructor also has the option to send a trainee's screen to a projector making active participation for each trainee possible.

This new system means that digital screen images can be transmitted to the trainees' stations. Highly developed electronics assure the images are transmitted without any loss of quality or time delay. A single cable is able to transmit resolutions of 1920 x 1200 @ 60 Hz and higher. This is possible within the basic version (not an additional option). The system is fully compatible with all digital screens and graphic boards.

Coursemaster DVI still retains many of the features of the original Coursemaster Select system that have made the system so popular.

- DVI still operates independently of the hardware, software and operating systems already in use.
- Modular design making the system easily extendable.
- No interference with your network performance
